

Easter Readiness in Norway (NRH)

Die Organisation Norwegischer Rettungshund (NRH) is in readiness around Easter. Thousands of Norwegians go to the mountains for vacation. This means skiing-and sometimes also accidents. The weather in the mountains is unpredictable and can change very fast.

Some people are not used to be in the mountains and overestimate themselves. It is easy to lose the way or an avalanche goes down. At the moment there is partially high danger of avalanches due to huge snow masses. Then it is good to know, that the Rescue dogs are not far away. At the moment there are extra dog teams in readiness, who are ready to start within a few minutes in case of an alert. NRH works together close with the Norwegian AirRescue. In case of an alert the dogs with their dog handlers will be flight in with helicopters, to start a search as soon as possible. Every minute counts after an avalanche!
