### **NON-Profit Declaration:**

We know that the funds of the IRO may only be used for statutory purposes as defined by the constitution. No person or institution may profit by claim expenses for anything which is not directly related to their official duties.

The NRO is obliged to send an annual detailed report to IRO what has happened with the money received from IRO sponsor money.

### **Regulations for participation in the IRO sponsorship-enlistment campaign.**

- 1.** The designated NRO participates in the international IRO sponsorship enlistment campaign. The NRO is thus obligated to support the advertising campaign during the entire advertising period in his or her own country through positive media activity, to the extent of the NRO's ability and through the forwarding of photos and information of his or her current activities to the IRO head office. Furthermore, the participating NRO agrees to a personal presentation in the IRO advertising brochure.
- 2.** The financial contributions made by promoting members and sponsors are administered by the IRO treasurer, and by 31.3. of the following year, at the latest, become available for payment according to the allocation key.
- 3.** NROs are obligated to return by deadline a completed statistics-form, sent by the IRO, to the IRO head office.
- 4.** From the first allocation of payment, NROs are obligated to submit a financial report by deadline concerning the use of the money received from the sponsorship enlistment for the previous year and declare his or her agreement to an inspection of the given statement by members of the IRO board.
- 5.** Each NRO is entitled to cancel the agreement for participation in sponsorship enlistment. Thus, also cancelled are the given obligations of the agreement.
- 6.** If the obligations are not fulfilled, or not fulfilled on time, or the NRO fails to comply with the agreement, the IRO board is authorised to decide on the further participation of the NRO in sponsorship enlistment.

### **Special regulation 2022 for 2021**

All eligible IRO member organisations will again receive IRO funding in 2022. Eligible are still those NROs that have at least the status "Search and Rescue Dog Handling Organisation", that have sent all required documents, as well as the proof of the use of funds and have paid the membership fee in time. If not all allocated funds could be used in 2021, proof of use of the remaining amounts can be submitted in 2023.

The lump sum will again be calculated with a higher percentage in the overall distribution this year and divided and paid out in equal parts to the eligible NROs. The promotional country bonus will be paid to NROs in Austria. As some, but not all of the planned IRO Testing Events took place in 2021, these will be rewarded with a lower percentage.

Furthermore, as last year, additional funding can be requested for training events, exercises, seminars or module events. Urgently needed and justified purchases can also be funded in this way. Applications for such funding can be submitted informally by all eligible organisations. The allocation of funds is made at short notice after review by decision of the Executive Board. Funding will be allocated as long as funds are available in the current year.
