## IRO MRT T Preparation

Tritolwerk (AT), 15.06. - 18.06.2026 (4 days)

### Information

The participants get an introduction into the IRO MRT T Guidelines and the IRO MRT T score sheet. They learn how the IRO MRT T is evaluated and what needs to be especially considered.

Major topics are **search tactics, asking for and using information, alerts and passing information to the Classifiers**. These will be handled in theory and practice. Also, **frequent mistakes, search patterns and the INSARAG Marking and Signaling system** will be discussed.

Regarding the practical search work the teams should show their current level, and will be evaluated by the Classifiers like at an MRT T.

At the end of each search, every team will receive a **detailed feedback** to prepare for the MRT T.

The training concludes with a summary feedback, that highlights the key points of the search exercises and serves as input for future training. At the end, participants receive personal feedback from the Classifiers regarding whether their current level of training is sufficient for the IRO MRT T.

**Please note** that the “First Aid for Dogs” module is not part of this training program. We recommend participating in the online seminar “First Aid for Dogs” on April 1, 2026 (DE) or April 8, 2026 (EN).
